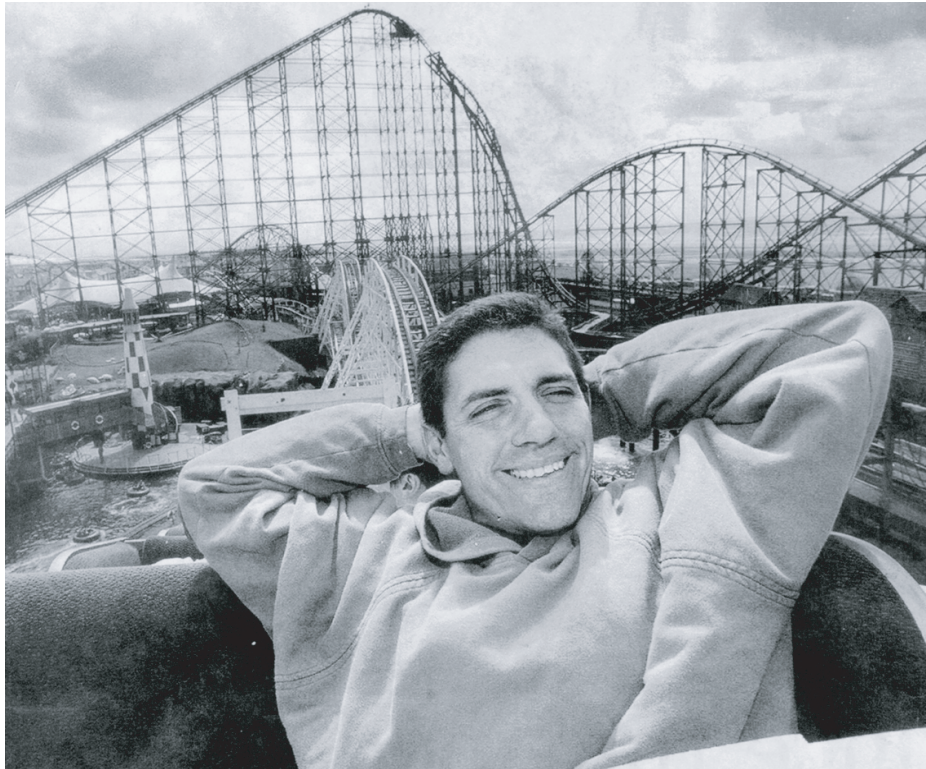

Can't stop now – I'm on a roll



Richard Rodriguez on one of the many high points of his continuing battle in Blackpool to hold on to his roller-coaster-riding record

1 Richard Rodriguez, 39, from Miami is very tired but he keeps going. He has already broken the world record for riding a roller coaster, but he won't get out of his carriage at Blackpool amusement park. At the same time Normand St Pierre is riding a roller coaster in Montreal, trying to break the world record too. "That roller coaster in Montreal is a killer," says Rodriguez.

2 The wind blows away his words as the roller coaster car makes a dip. "I can't say when I will stop. First I have to know what St Pierre is doing." Mr Rodriguez's supporters are keeping an eye on his rival via the Internet but there's no sign that St Pierre is giving up.

3 The roller coaster marathon started in Blackpool on 18 June when Rodriguez, who has held the world record since 1994, began a non-stop ride with only a five-minute break every hour. St Pierre started his record attempt in Montreal 48 hours later.

4 Rodriguez broke the world record last Wednesday, but he's still on the ride which throws him 70ft into the air and then drops him to ground level, reaching speeds of 35 miles per hour.

5 He gets about five hours' sleep per night in the carriage which has been specially changed for him. He can stretch his legs because the iron bar in the middle is removed and two side panels have been put in so his belongings won't fall out.

6 There is plenty of foam-rubber and a piece of canvas to protect him during the night. He wears ear plugs to be sure he gets some sleep. In the morning he spends about an hour – all his five-minute breaks put together – out of the carriage to take a hot shower and eat breakfast. He eats snacks and other meals on the ride. He reads newspapers between dips when his carriage is not going so fast.

7 "The weather hasn't been too kind," Rodriguez said, looking tired and worn out. "I haven't been getting a lot of sleep because of the wind and rain." He was afraid of roller coasters as a child but overcame the fear at the age of 16, when he made a ride in Coney Island. He set his first roller coaster record on that same day in 1977.

Girls sent home for wearing trousers

1 A head teacher has been accused of discrimination because he has refused to allow girl pupils to wear trousers. A group of fifth-formers was sent home for breaking the 'skirts-only' rule for girls at Cleeve School in Gloucestershire.

2 One of the protesters, Kerrie George, 15, said: "At this time of year the weather is freezing. Skirts don't offer much protection. All we want is to be allowed black trousers during the winter months. We're not against school

uniforms, we just want to be treated the same as boys."

3 Mr Brian Gardiner, head of the school said: "If the girls want to stay warm they can wear tights. Skirts look better on girls. A lot of the girls who wear trousers do not look tidy. Trousers can be part of the uniform, but only for boys.

1 **L**ucy and I met in the first year of secondary school.

We had lots in common and she gave me a funny nickname: Kassie. We did everything together and became best mates.

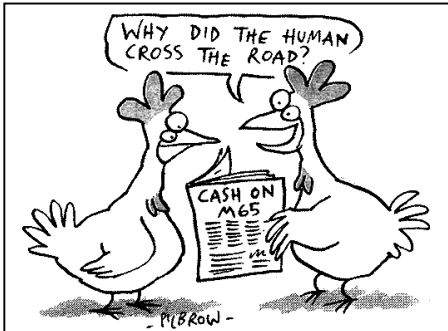

The road to fortune
